Noel B. Salazar obtained his PhD in anthropology from the University of Pennsylvania (USA). He is Founding Director of Cultural Mobilities Research (CuMoRe) at the University of Leuven (Belgium) and Senior Research Fellow of the Research Foundation – Flanders. In addition, he is Visiting Research Associate at the Centre for Tourism and Cultural Change, Leeds Metropolitan University (UK). From 2011 until 2013, he serves as Executive Committee member of the European Association of Social Anthropologists. Dr. Salazar's research interests include anthropologies of mobility and travel, the local-to-global nexus, discourses and imaginaries of Otherness, heritage, cultural brokering and cosmopolitanism. He is the author of *Envisioning Eden: Mobilizing Imaginaries in Tourism and Beyond* (2010, Oxford: Berghahn) and numerous peer-reviewed articles and book chapters on the anthropology of tourism and heritage. Dr. Salazar is on the editorial boards of *Annals of Tourism Research*, *International Journal of Tourism Anthropology*, *Social Anthropology*, *AIBR - Revista de Antropología Iberoamericana*, *Mondes du Tourisme*, and the *European Journal of Tourism and Hospitality Research*. He is also on UNESCO's and UNWTO's roster of consultants, an expert member of the ICOMOS International Cultural Tourism Committee, and an expert panel member of the National Geographic Society's Center for Sustainable Destinations.
