Jan Turtinen holds a Ph D in ethnology from Stockholm University. His research interests include globalisation, heritage politics, international organisations and translocal ethnography. Turtinen has done extensive research on UNESCO's World Heritage Convention. He finalised his doctor's dissertation *UNESCO's World Heritage: On the Preconditions of International Policy* in 2006. Turtinen gives lectures and participates in conferences on the subject both as a researcher and as a civil servant. Since 2007 Turtinen is senior advisor at the Swedish National Heritage Board. In this capacity he has been a member of Sweden's delegation to UNESCO's World Heritage Committee representing Sweden and coordinating the delegation's work in the Committee during its term 2007 – 2011. Turtinen has participated at several World Heritage Committee sessions and expert meetings. He has also had an internship at the World Heritage Centre at UNESCO headquarters in Paris as part of his dissertation project.
